

Wearable Art Review Entry Guidelines

Deadline for entry is Saturday, July 24th at 5pm at Harriett Hall. NO EXCEPTIONS.

While encouraged, entrants are not obligated to submit their design to be judged in the Exhibit Hall.

Entrants may submit multiple entries but are only allowed to model one of those entries.

Models must be supplied for all other entries submitted.

Original Design: The wearable arts entry must be an original concept designed and created by the entrant(s). This applies to all major components of the piece, but does not extend to the undergarments meant as a background to the piece. The entry may, however, have previously been displayed at another Wearable Art Show. Questions about a potential entry's originality of design and creation should be directed to the Fair Office at 766-2476 or madeline@seakfair.org.

Modeling: Entrants must designate a model for their creation, or be prepared to model the piece themselves at the Fair. If you do not have a model in Haines, please contact the Fair Office to discuss your options. Please plan (or make plans with your model) to arrive at LEAST one hour before to dress, apply makeup, line up, and walk to and from the stage.

Music: Entrants must submit music that will play while their piece is modeled on the Fair's Main Stage. Music should be a "radio edit" (clean of profanity) and should enhance the audience's experience of the piece. Music must be submitted as a MP3 file via email and **NO LESS** than 2 minutes in length.

Restrictions: Entries should be safe for models to wear and the public to view. Use of fire, explosives, animals, sharp objects, or firearms in costuming or exhibition is prohibited. The Fair reserves the right to exclude work that is deemed inappropriate for our all-ages audience.

Narrative: This will be utilized as an introduction as the model enters the stage. This should include information describing the design and/or the creative process involved. The introduction will last about 30 seconds and should be approximately 250 words.

Fair Admission: Entrants and models will receive free admission the day of the show.

The Southeast Alaska State Fair reserves the right to accept or reject any entry.
