- The wearable art entry must be an original concept designed and created by the entrant(s). The entry cannot use fire, explosives, live animals, or weaponry.
- A brief statement describing the function, type of design and materials used should be included.
- Judging will be done based on the entry's originality, artistic merit and vision, creativity, use of materials, and design.
- **Entries for the purpose of display and education only are welcomed, encouraged, and will not be judged.**
